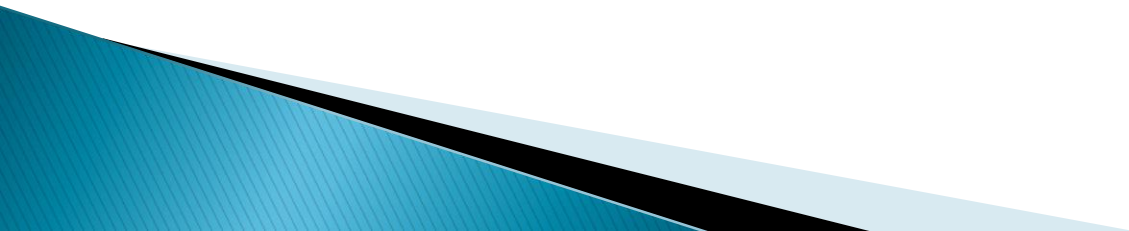

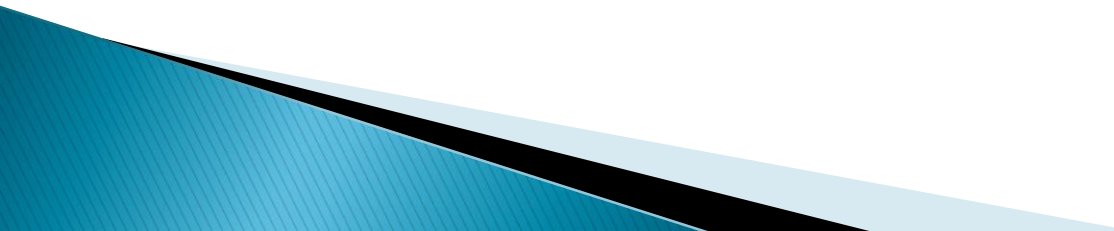
SQL Standardization

- ▶ MySQL aims “to support the full ANSI/ISO SQL standard, but without making concessions to speed and quality of the code.”

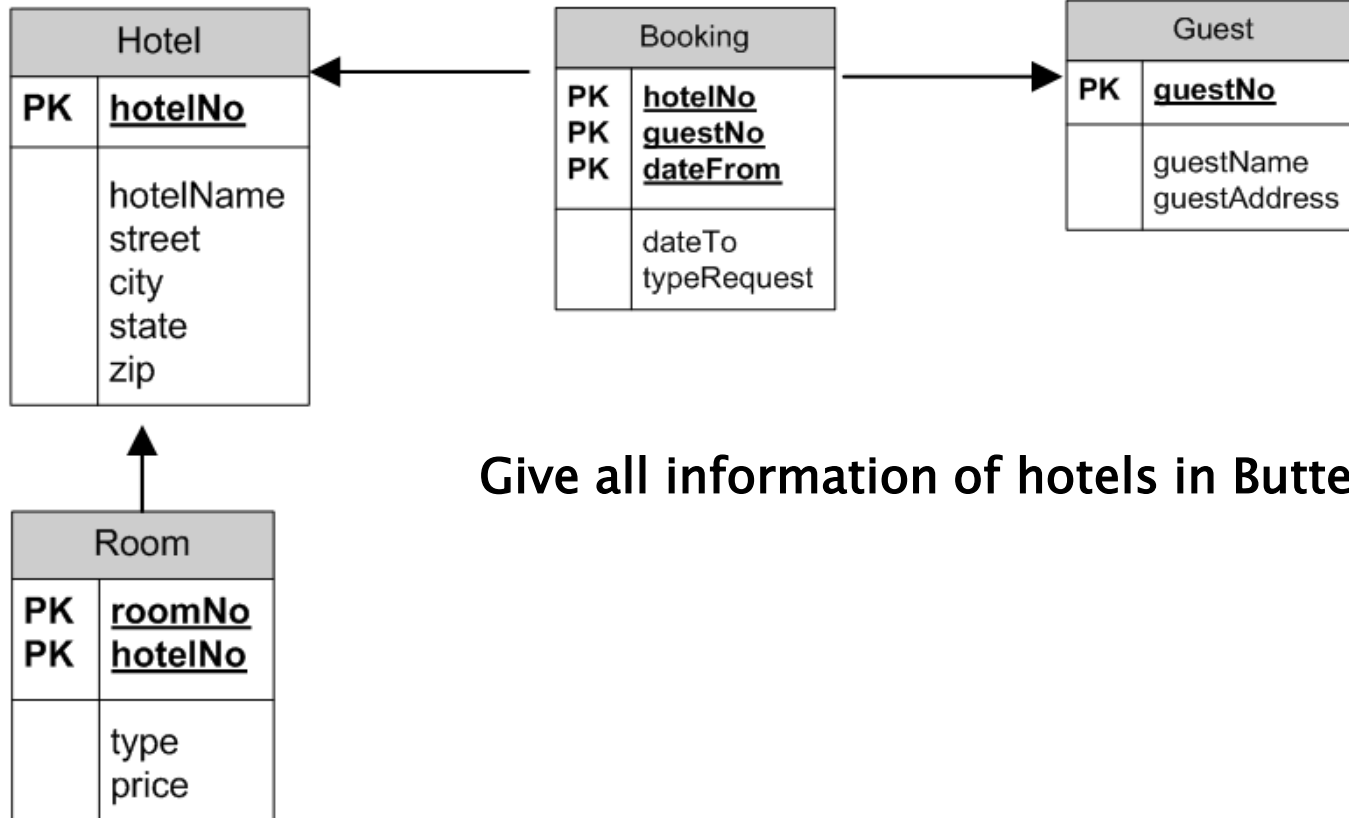

SQL – Syntax

```
SELECT [DISTINCT | ALL]
        {* | colExpression [AS newName]] [,...]}
FROM TableName [alias][,...]
[WHERE condition]
[GROUP BY columnList] [HAVING condition]
[ORDER BY columnList];
```

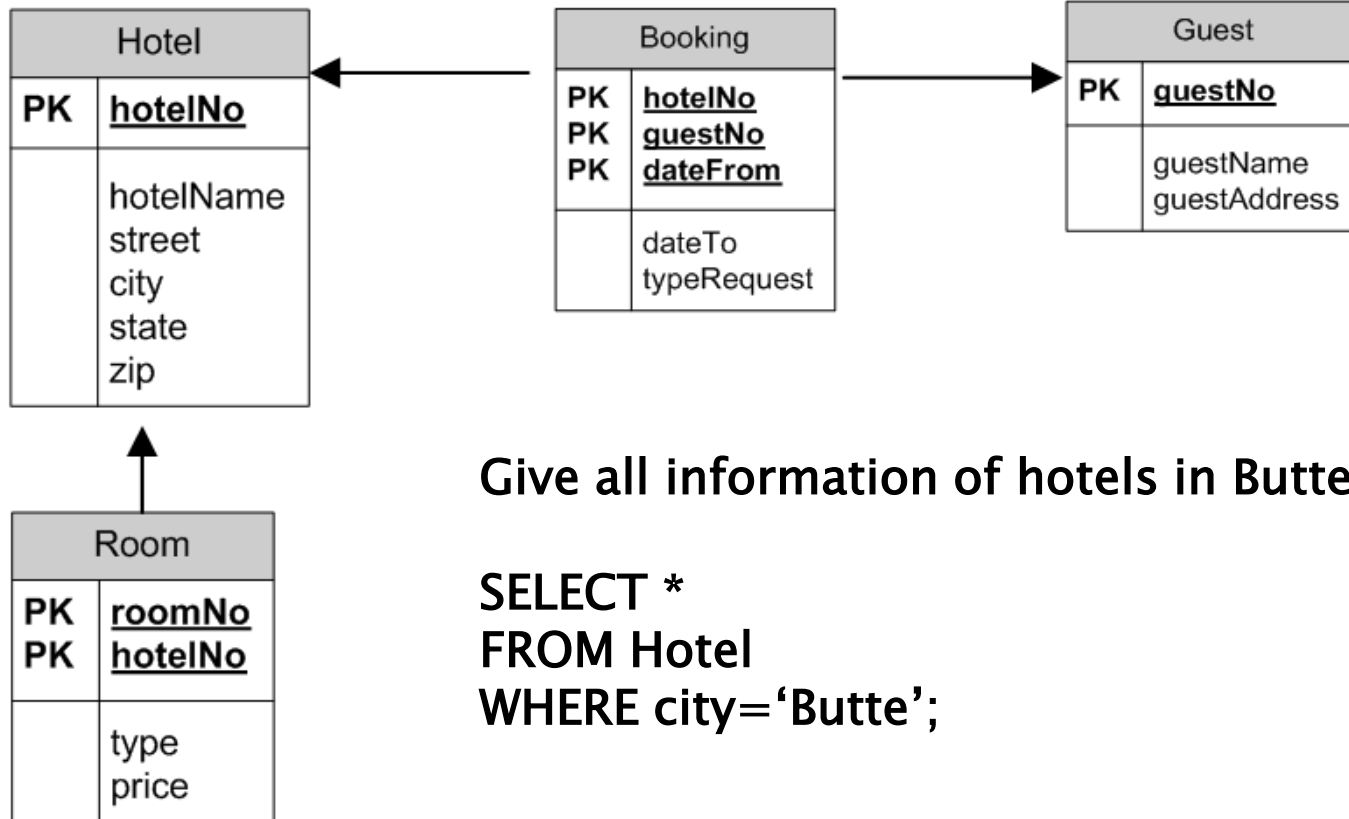


Query 1



Give all information of hotels in Butte:

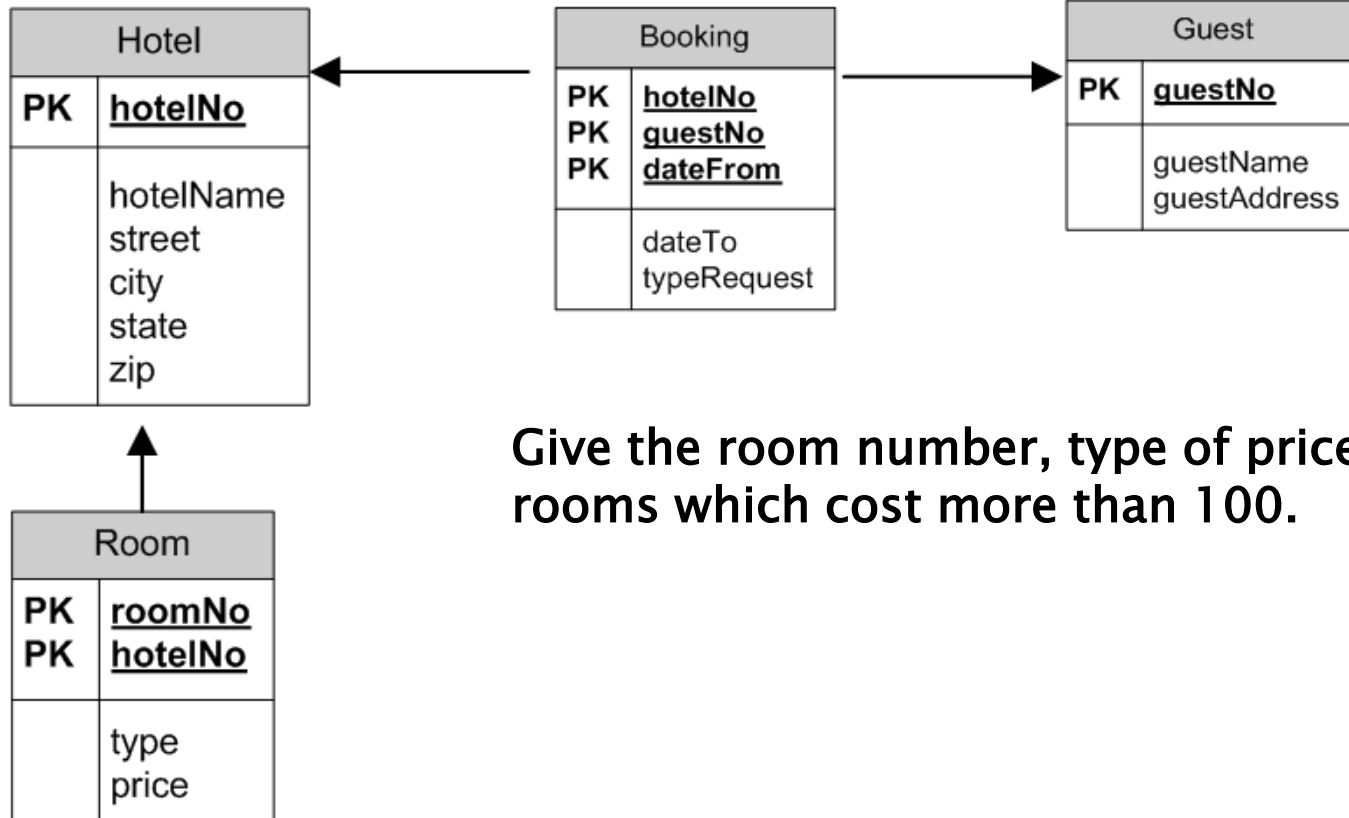
Query 1 – Answer



Give all information of hotels in Butte:

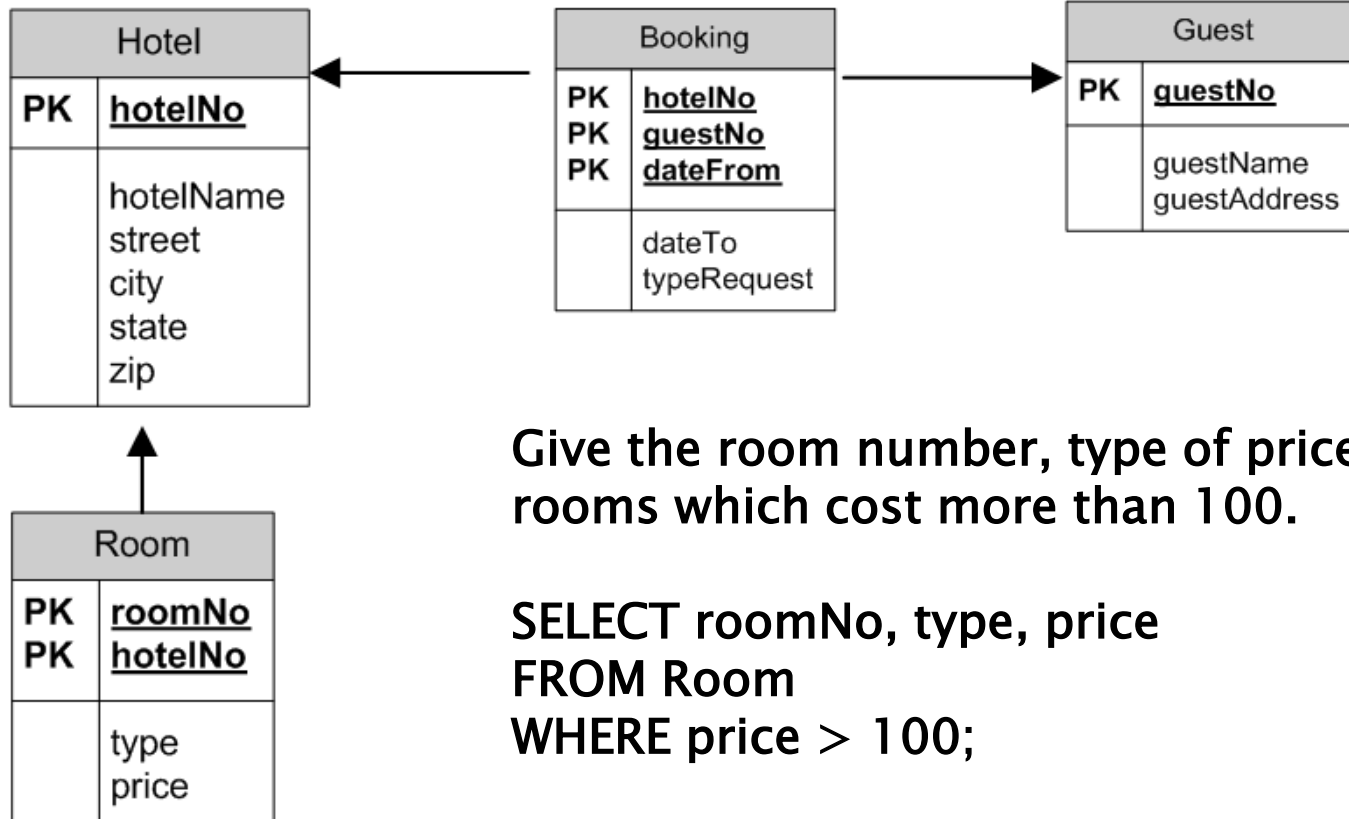
```

```

Query 2



Give the room number, type of price of all rooms which cost more than 100.

Query 2 – Answer



Give the room number, type of price of all rooms which cost more than 100.

```
SELECT roomNo, type, price  
FROM Room  
WHERE price > 100;
```
