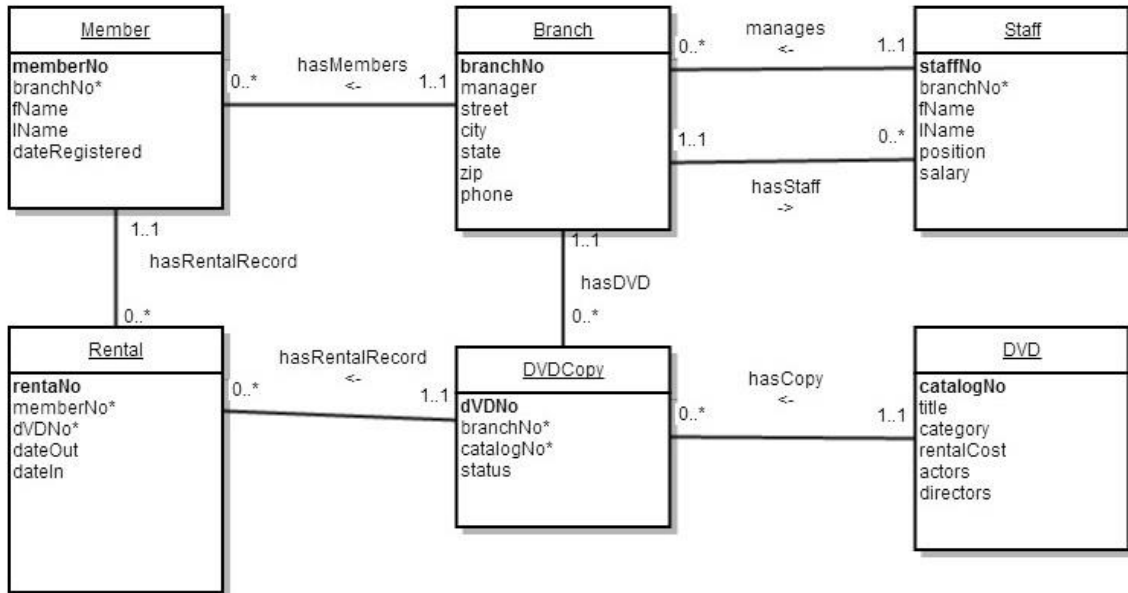

**Member:**

memberNo – CHAR(7)  
 fName – CHAR(30)  
 lName – CHAR(30)  
 dateRegistered – DATE

**Rental:**

rentalNo – INTEGER (auto increment)  
 dateOut - DATE  
 dateIn – DATE

**Branch:**

branchNo – CHAR(4)  
 street – VARCHAR(100)  
 city – CHAR(30)  
 state – CHAR(2)  
 zip – CHAR(5)  
 phone – CHAR(10)

**DVD:**

catalogNo – CHAR(8)  
 title – VARCHAR(200)  
 category – CHAR(10)  
 rentalCost – SMALLMONEY  
 actors – VARCHAR(1000)  
 directors – VARCHAR(1000)

**Staff:**

staffNo – CHAR(7)  
 fName – CHAR(30)  
 lName – CHAR(30)  
 position – CHAR(30)  
 salary - SMALLMONEY

**DVDCopy:**

dVDNo – INTEGER (auto increment)  
 status –CHAR(10)

1. Create the tables above, using Microsoft's SQL Server, within your personal database.

Here is a script to create the Branch and Staff tables:

```
CREATE TABLE Branch
(branchNo CHAR(4) PRIMARY KEY,
manager CHAR(7),
street VARCHAR(100),
city CHAR(30),
state CHAR(2),
zip CHAR(5),
phone CHAR(10))

CREATE TABLE Staff
(staffNo CHAR(7) PRIMARY KEY,
branchNo CHAR(4) CONSTRAINT staff_branch_FK
FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES Branch(branchNo),
fName CHAR(30),
lName CHAR(30),
position CHAR(30),
salary SMALLMONEY)

/* Add the manager reference */
ALTER TABLE Branch
ADD CONSTRAINT branch_manager_FK
FOREIGN KEY (manager) REFERENCES Staff(staffNo)
```

If you make a mistake and need to drop the tables:

```
/*
ALTER TABLE Branch
DROP CONSTRAINT branch_manager_FK

DROP TABLE Staff

DROP TABLE Member

DROP TABLE Branch
*/
```

I typically use scripts to create databases. If you would like, you can also use the SQLServer graphical interface. To use the graphical interface, right click "Tables" in the Object Explorer.

2. Place at least three records into each table.

Here is a script to insert records into the Branch and Staff tables:

                  position, salary) VALUES ('S333333','B299',

                  position, salary) VALUES ('S654321','B299',
        'Rio', 'Riley','stocker','12.00')

INSERT INTO Staff (staffNo, branchNo, fName, lName,
                  position, salary) VALUES ('S123456','B299',
        'Jill', 'Kon','manager','22.00')

UPDATE Branch
SET manager='S123456' WHERE branchNo='B299'

INSERT INTO DVD (catalogNo, title, category,
 rentalCost, actors, directors)
VALUES ('DR199', 'Great Gatsby', 'drama', 5.99,
 'Toby Maguire, Leonardo DiCaprio, Carey Mulligan',
 'Baz Luhrmann')

CREATE TABLE DVDCopy
(dVDNo INTEGER IDENTITY(1,1) PRIMARY KEY,
 catalogNo CHAR(8) CONSTRAINT dVDCopy_catalog_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES DVD(catalogNo),
 status CHAR(10))

INSERT INTO DVDCopy (catalogNo, status)
VALUES ('DR199', 'scratched')

CREATE TABLE Rental
(rentalNo INTEGER IDENTITY(1,1) PRIMARY KEY,
 memberNo CHAR(7) CONSTRAINT rental_member_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES Member(memberNo),
 dVDNo INTEGER CONSTRAINT rental_dVDCopy_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES DVDCopy(dVDNo),
 dateOut DATE,
 dateIn DATE)

INSERT INTO Rental (memberNo, dVDNo, dateOut, dateIn)
VALUES ('M223344', 1, '2016-2-5', '2016-2-10')

3. The current design allows any text to be entered as a category. Fix the design so that only the categories: action, comedy, drama, and foreign are allowed.

Using a CHECK constraint:

```
CREATE TABLE DVD
(catalogNo CHAR(8) PRIMARY KEY,
 title VARCHAR(200),
 category CHAR(10) CONSTRAINT category_CK
    CHECK(category IN ('action', 'comedy',
                      'drama', 'foreign', 'sci fi')),
 rentalCost SMALLMONEY,
 actors VARCHAR(1000),
 directors VARCHAR(100))
```

Using a Category tables:

```
CREATE TABLE Category
(categoryId INTEGER IDENTITY(1,1) PRIMARY KEY,
 category CHAR(30))

CREATE TABLE DVD
(catalogNo CHAR(8) PRIMARY KEY,
 title VARCHAR(200),
 category INTEGER CONSTRAINT category_FK
    FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES Category(categoryId),
 rentalCost SMALLMONEY,
 actors VARCHAR(1000),
 directors VARCHAR(100))
```

4. Write a query which gives, for each branch, the name of the branch manager (first and last), along with the title and category of each movie that has been rented from that branch, and the name of the person (first and last) who rented the movie.

?????

Extra Credit: The current design allows any text to be entered as actors and directors. If an actor plays in multiple movies, their name will be repeated in several different DVD tables. If the actor changes their name, it will need to be changed in several tables.

Avoid this repetition by creating an Actor table and an AppearsIn table. Actors are listed once in the Actor table. The AppearsIn table allows several actors to appear in each DVD, and each DVD to have several actors which appear in it.

Create a table of Actors/Directors:

```
CREATE TABLE ActorDirector
(actorDirectorId INTEGER IDENTITY(1,1) PRIMARY KEY,
 name CHAR(50))
```

Requires adding "join" tables:

```
CREATE TABLE DVDActors
(catalogNo CHAR(8) CONSTRAINT dvd_dvdActors_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES DVD(catalogNo),
 actorId INTEGER CONSTRAINT actor_dvdActors_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES ActorDirector(actorDirectorId),
 PRIMARY KEY (catalogNo, actorId))
```

```
CREATE TABLE DVDDirectory
(catalogNo CHAR(8) CONSTRAINT dvd_dvdDirector_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES DVD(catalogNo),
 directorId INTEGER CONSTRAINT actOr_dvdActors_FK
 FOREIGN KEY REFERENCES ActorDirector(actorDirectorId),
 PRIMARY KEY (catalogNo, directorId))
```
