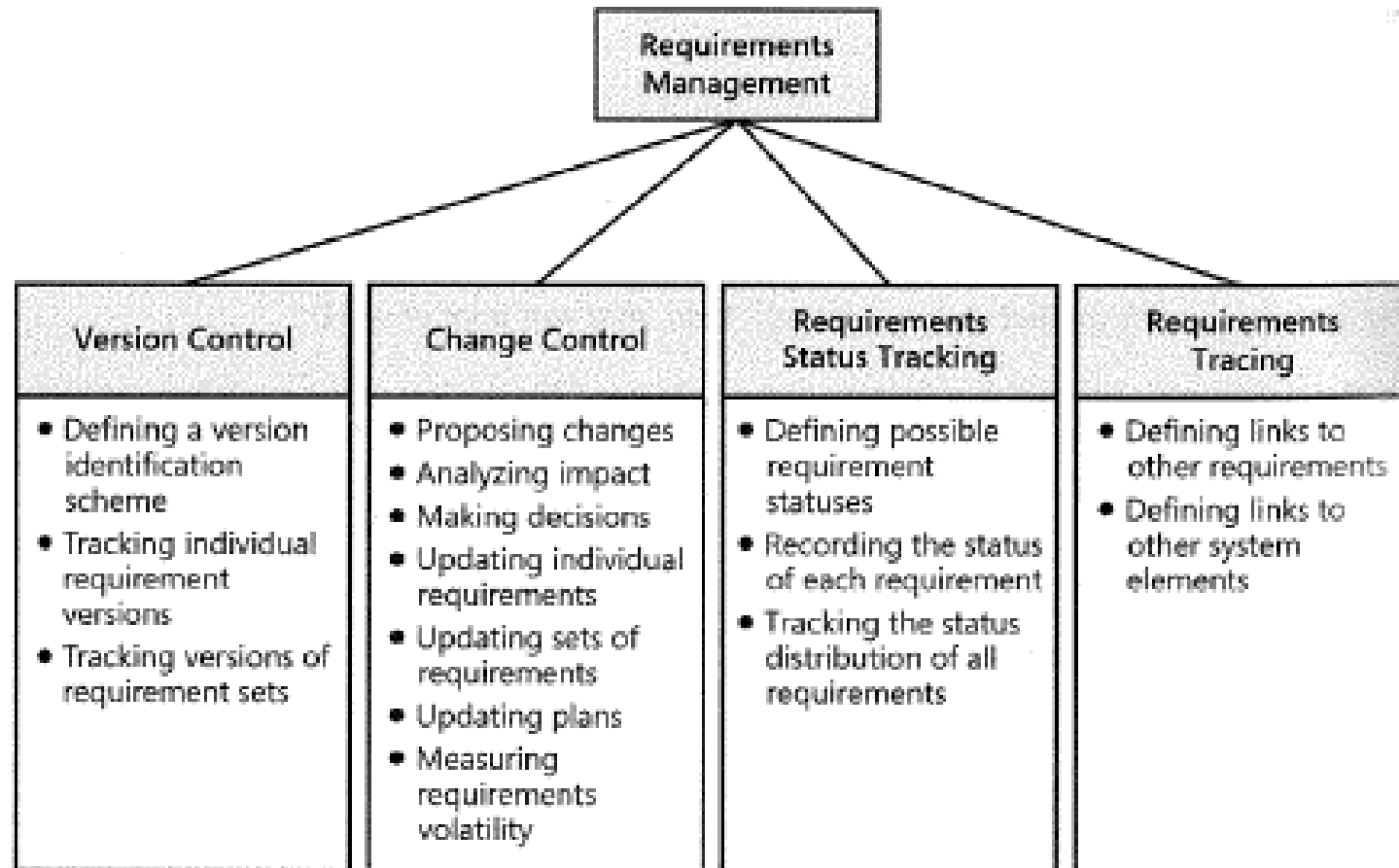


FIGURE 27-1 Major requirements management activities.

Requirements BASELINE

“A snapshot in time that represents the current agreed-upon, reviewed, and approved set of requirements, often defining the contents of a specific product release or development iteration. Serves as the basis for further development work.”

Tracking Distribution of Requirements Statuses (pg. 466)

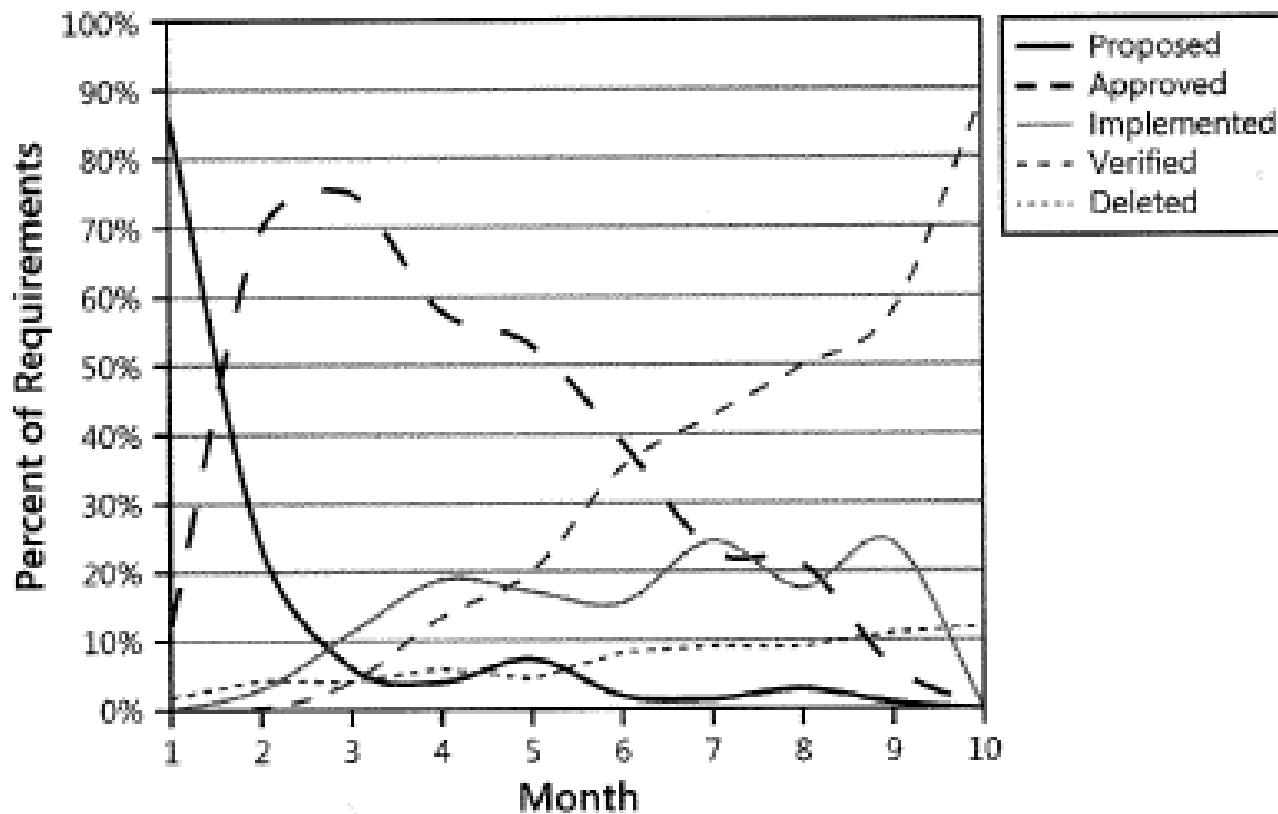


FIGURE 27-2 Tracking the distribution of requirements status throughout a project's development cycle

Common types of Requirements Issues (pg. 467)

Common Types of Requirements Issues:

- Requirement question
- Missing requirement
- Incorrect requirement
- Implementation question
- Duplicate requirement
- Unneeded requirement

Recall from before, common requirements problems:

- Omitting requirements
- Ambiguous requirements
- Missing stakeholders
- Including design
- Gold plating
- Scope creep (more of a problem after baselining)

Agile Burndown Chart (pg. 470)

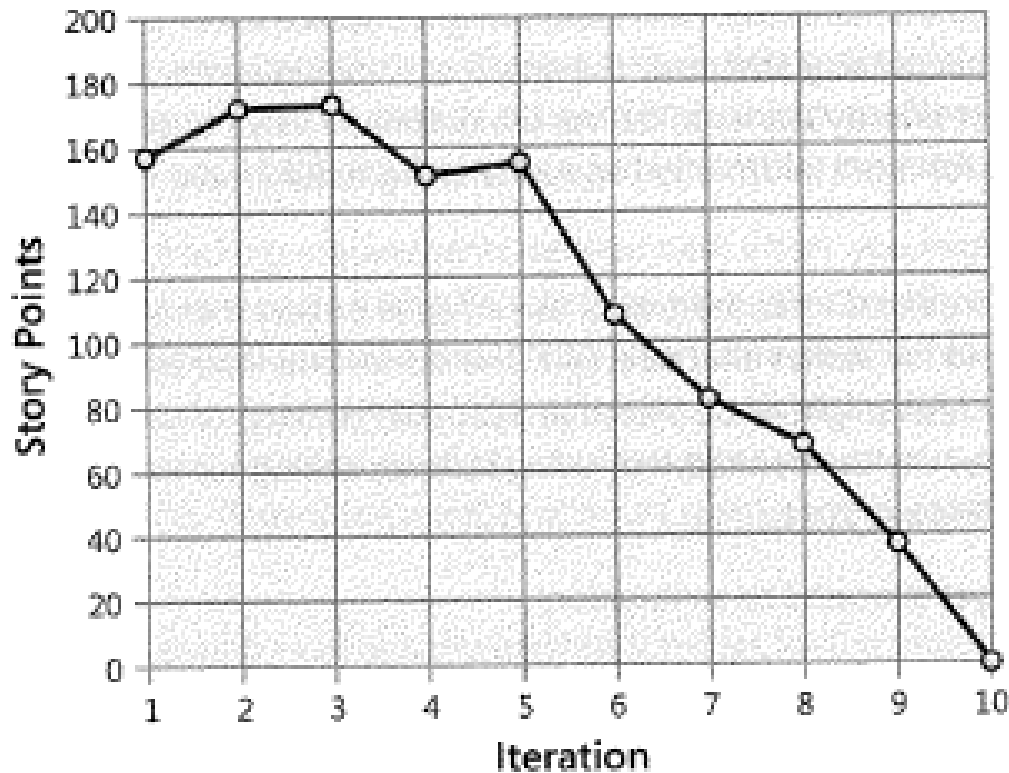


FIGURE 27-3 Sample iteration burndown chart for monitoring the product backlog on an agile project.
